

**TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2011-03**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK AND INCREASING THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE TO ELEVEN REGULAR MEMBERS**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 003.32 entitled "Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee," Subsection 003.34.010 entitled "Establishment; composition; terms and organization," of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Pequannock, shall be amended as follows:

**Subsection 003.32.010 Establishment; composition; terms; organization.**


The Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee shall consist of eleven (11) voting members to be appointed by The Township Council. All members shall be residents of the Township of Pequannock. Members shall be appointed for a three (3) year term. The Township Council may also appoint one (1) resident under the age of twenty-one (21) for a one year term to serve as a non-voting youth liaison for a one (1) year term. Members of the Committee shall serve without compensation. The Recreation Director of the Township shall serve as Executive Secretary of the Committee. The Committee shall designate one (1) of its members to serve as chairperson and presiding officer of the Committee. The Committee may also appoint a Secretary whose compensation will be determined by the Township Manager. The Committee is authorized to adopt bylaws governing its procedural operations.


**Section 2.** If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

**Section 3.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
