

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-05

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK AND ELIMINATING THE MAXIMUM AGE RESTRICTION FOR VOLUNTEER DEPARTMENT MEMBERS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Section 003.32 entitled "Fire Department," Subsection 003.18.010 entitled "Composition of Fire Department; membership restrictions," of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Pequannock, shall be amended as follows:

Subsection 003.18.010 Composition of Fire Department; membership restrictions.

The Fire Department shall consist of a Fire Department liaison representative from the township governing body and two (2) volunteer fire companies plus a Chief for each company. The fire fighters shall not be less than eighteen (18) years old at the time their application for membership in the Fire Department is presented to the Township Manager for approval. In addition, there shall be nine (9) fire marshals attached to each company appointed by the Township Manager.

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.


Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
