ORDINANCE NO. 2011-18

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$423,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. \$423,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

PURPOSE	Amount Appropriated
(a) Upgrades and repairs to municipal buildings including repairs and roof replacement at Town Hall; Generator replacement, Fire Systems upgrades and building repairs at Engine Co #2.	\$ 78,000
(b) Construction of Sidewalks along the Boulevard to replace deteriorated and heaved sections of Sidewalk; Construction of ADA Compliant Intersection Ramps, Replacement of unsafe sidewalk sections and Drainage Improvements throughout the Township.	\$ 71,250
(c) Upgrade & Replacement of street signs to meet visibility standards	\$ 20,250
(d) Upgrades and repairs to Emergency Management equipment an response systems, including replacement Fire Sirens and Traffic Control Preemption Devices	\$ 26,500
(e) Improvements to Parks: Improvements to Washington Park including Field and Parking Facilities.	\$ 37,900
(f) Purchase and installation of technology equipment and upgrades for the Police Department including E 911 System Replacement, ALPR Equipment, Upgrade to the CAD / Records System and Replacement of the In-car Video System.	\$171,100
(g) Purchase of Firefighter Bailout Systems for the Fire Department	\$ 7,750
(h) Purchase trees to replace ones that have died in the public right-of-way.	\$ 10,250
TOTAL	\$423,000

SECTION 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$7,400.00 for items of expense listed in and permitted under NJSA 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.

SECTION 3. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by law.
