

TOWNSHIP of PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-19

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$407,000 FOR FINANCING THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. \$31,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Fund Balance; \$80,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Vehicle Replacement; \$72,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for DPW Equipment; \$200,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Road Resurfacing; \$24,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Data & Office Equipment, thereby in aggregate appropriating \$407,000 for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

PURPOSE	Amount Appropriated
(a) Replace Approximately 15 PC Systems that are 4 years old or older for various municipal offices; purchase of an MDT for the Office of Fire Safety; replacement of PC's for the Library; and purchase of a mountable radar unit.	\$ 25,000
(b) Resurfacing of various roads in the Township to include milling and paving and various curb and drainage repairs as necessary.	\$ 205,000
(c) Building Repairs including the purchase of AC compressors for the Library and repairs at the DPW Garage.	\$ 18,750
(d) Replace administrative vehicles for use by the Health Department; Purchase a Bucket Truck / a Chipper Box and a 16' Field Mower for the Department of Public Works.	\$ 153,000
(e) Purchase of High Band Pagers for the Fire Department.	\$ 5,250
TOTAL	\$ 407,000


SECTION 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$8,000 for items of expense listed in and permitted under NJSA 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.

SECTION 3. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by law.
