

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 129 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK AND REVISING OPERATING POLICIES AND FEES FOR PEQUANNOCK VALLEY PARK AND WOODLAND LAKE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 129, Section 129.02.090 to be entitled "Pequannock Valley Park and Woodland Lake Operating Policy; Fees," of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Pequannock shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

129.02.090 Pequannock Valley Park and Woodland Lake Operating Policy; Fees

A. The Pequannock Valley Park ("PV Park") swimming and beach area and the Woodland Park boating and Fishing Area shall be restricted to those who have obtained membership badges, daily badges, or are approved group users. It shall be a violation of this Chapter for any person to use the swimming facility or boating/fishing areas without a proper badge. All badges are nontransferable and it is a violation of this Chapter for any person who has been issued a badge to allow it to be used by another, or for a person who has not been issued a badge to use or attempt to use a badge to gain entry into the facilities.

B. Pequannock residents shall be eligible to purchase season badges for the swimming facility. Up to 100 Non-Resident Family Memberships may also be issued for the use of the swimming facility. Non-Resident Family Memberships will be issued on a first come, first serve basis when completed membership applications are received by the Recreation Department. Pequannock residents and their guests shall be eligible to purchase daily badges. The resident must remain with their guests at all times when utilizing the facilities.

C. Fees: Fees for badges are established as follows:

(1) Seasonal P.V. Park Swimming Facility and Woodland Lake Boating and Fishing Facility Family Membership:

Each Additional	25.00	25.00

* An additional fee of \$10.00 shall be charged after June 12

* A caregiver membership may be purchased for an additional \$105.00 for a resident caregiver or \$130.00 for a non-resident caregiver.

(2) Seasonal Woodland Lake boating and fishing membership only:

Single	\$ 20.00
Family	\$ 27.00

* An additional fee of \$10.00 shall be charged after June 12

(3) Seasonal P.V. Park swimming facility and/or Woodland Lake boating and fishing facility senior citizen badges shall be available to Pequannock Township residents over the age of 65 as follows:

Single	\$ 30.00
Husband/Wife	\$ 45.00

* An additional fee of \$10.00 shall be charged after June 12

- (4) Daily guest badges for the use of the PV Park swimming facility and/or the Woodland Lake boating and fishing facility shall be available to Pequannock residents and guests of Pequannock residents at the following fees:

(5) Corporate Memberships:

- a. One hundred twenty dollars (\$120.00) each badge.
 - b. Restricted to weekday use, Monday through Friday, 10:00 am - 8:00 pm. Corporation shall be a corporate taxpayer in the Township of Pequannock.
 - c. Corporation purchasing corporate membership badges must submit a certificate of insurance naming the Township of Pequannock as a coinsured in an amount of not less than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000).
- (6) P.V. Park swimming facility group user fees: All groups of more than twenty-five (25) must have prior approval from the Director of Parks & Recreation or the Park Manager. All persons must have a season or daily badge except that the following fees shall apply to camps or daycare groups providing supervision and insurance:

Group User Rate	\$1.00 per child per Day
Non-Profit Groups	\$0.50 per child per Day

All Group users will submit a daily log to the Park Manager. Logs are subject to verification by park staff. The amount due will be determined at the end of each week and must be paid in full prior to entering the park the following week.

- (7) The fee for lost badges at either facility shall be twenty dollars (\$20.00) per badge.
 - (8) Memberships and badges may be revoked by the Recreation Director for violation of the rules and regulations governing the facilities. There will be no refund of fees for membership or badges revoked by the Recreation Director for violation of the rules and regulations.
 - (9) New Boat Registration Fee: All boats must be registered at the Parks and Recreation office and pay an annual fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00).
- D. There shall be no boating or fishing in the PV Park swimming facility and no swimming in the Woodland Lake boating and fishing facility.
- E. No person using the facilities shall leave a motor vehicle parked on adjacent or nearby streets.
- F. Closed areas. Any section or part of any park may be declared closed to the public by the Director at any time for an interval of time, either temporarily or at regular and stated intervals (daily or otherwise) and either entirely or merely to certain uses, as the Director shall find reasonably necessary.
- G. Facility hours will be established by the Recreation Director on an annual basis and shall be posted at the facilities

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or


provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
