

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 129 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK AND REVISING DAILY USE FEES FOR PEQUANNOCK VALLEY PARK AND WOODLAND LAKE AND ESTABLISHING A NON-RESIDENT FEE FOR BARK PARK TAGS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 129, Section 129.02.090 entitled "Pequannock Valley Park and Woodland Lake Operating Policy; Fees," of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Pequannock shall be amended by the following amendment to Subsection C (4) which shall read as follows:

(4) Daily guest badges for the use of the PV Park swimming facility shall be available at the following fees:

Section 2. Chapter 129, Section 129.06.010 entitled "Pequannock Township Dog Park" of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Pequannock shall be amended by the following amendment to Subsection A which shall read as follows:

A. Pass Required: The Pequannock Township Dog Park may only be used for dogs which have been registered with the Recreation Department and have obtained a Dog Park Pass. Residents shall not be charged a fee for Dog Park tags. The fee for a non-resident Dog Park tag shall be \$25.00. The owner and any individual responsible for bringing a dog which does not have a pass to the Dog Park shall be deemed in violation of this Chapter.


Section 3. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
