

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-07

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF AN EMERGENCY SUPPORT VEHICLE FOR THE FIRST AID SQUAD BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$180,000.00 FOR FINANCING THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock (not less than two-thirds of all members affirmatively concurring) as follows:

Section 1. A modern, reliable emergency support vehicle / light rescue is required for the effective operation of the Pequannock Township First Aid and Rescue Squad. The purchase of a replacement support vehicle is deemed to be necessary and is to be completed under the direction of the Pequannock Township First Aid and Rescue Squad. This improvement is hereby authorized to be undertaken by the Township of Pequannock as a general improvement.

Section 2. To finance said improvement as set forth in section 1 hereof, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$180,000.00 from Prior Years Capital Reserve Funds for Purchase of Vehicles.

Section 3. The improvement hereby authorized and the purpose for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$1,000.00 for items of expense listed in and permitted under NJSA 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.

Section 4. The capital budget of the Township of Pequannock is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.


Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by law.
