

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-09

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$232,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. \$232,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

PURPOSE	Amount Appropriated
(a) Upgrades and repairs to municipal buildings including repairs and Roof Replacement at Town Hall; Emergency Generator Upgrades and Installations and Carpet and Flooring improvements at Senior House.	\$ 89,000
(b) Acquisition of a Folder / Stuffer machine to process billing and mailings at the Municipal Building.	\$ 10,000
(c) Acquisition of an Equipment Trailer for use by the Parks Maintenance Division of the Public Works Department.	\$ 12,000
(d) Roadway and Crosswalk improvements at various locations along the Newark Pompton Turnpike to improve pedestrian safety to include sidewalk and crossing upgrades, improved roadway markings and signage.	\$ 30,500
(e) [Intentionally removed]	
(f) Purchase of office furnishings for the Police Department.	\$ 10,000
(g) Purchase of safety and rescue equipment for the Fire Department, including Firefighter Bailout Systems and Replacement of Rescue Boats and Water Safety Equipment.	\$ 60,500
(h) Purchase trees to replace ones that have died in the public right-of-way.	\$ 10,000
(i) Drainage improvements at various locations throughout the Township including materials necessary for same.	\$ 10,000
TOTAL	\$232,000

SECTION 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$13,250.00 for items of expense listed in and permitted under NJSA 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.

SECTION 3. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by law.
