

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-21

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 150 ENTITLED "INDIVIDUAL SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris and State of New Jersey that Chapter 150 entitled "Individual Sewage Disposal System" of the Township Code is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 150.04 is hereby amended to read as follows

**150.04 Fee Established.**

There shall be a fee established pursuant to the Chapter as follows:

- A. For the filing of an application and plans for a permit to locate, and construct, alter, or repair an individual sewage disposal system, one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00).
- ~~B. For the filing of an application and plans for a permit to alter an existing individual sewage disposal system, one hundred dollars (\$100.00).~~
- ~~C. For the filing of an application and plans for a permit to repair an existing individual sewage disposal system, twenty five dollars (\$25.00).~~
- B. For the filing of an application and plans for a permit to repair a baffle, connecting pipe, or distribution box of an individual sewage disposal system, twenty-five dollars (\$25.00.)
- ~~D.C.~~ For each reinspection of an individual sewage disposal system or part thereof, caused by the failure of the permittee to locate and construct or alter the same in accordance with the terms of the permit issued or the terms of the code adopted by this Chapter, an inspection fee of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) shall be charged.


**SECTION 2.** If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.


**SECTION 3.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
