

**TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2014-22**

**BOND ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3(A) OF BOND ORDINANCE  
NUMBERED 2014-02 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF  
MORRIS, NEW JERSEY FINALLY ADOPTED FEBRUARY 25, 2014 IN ORDER TO  
AMEND THE DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL  
PROPERTIES.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. Section 3(a) of Bond Ordinance numbered 2014-02 of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey (the "Township"), finally adopted February 25, 2014, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The improvement hereby authorized and the purpose for the financing of which the bonds are to be issued the Sanitary Sewer Extension Project and related improvements to complete projects 14-2 and 14-7 of the Sewer Master Plan, including the Village Road area, including Greendale Avenue and Winding Way, Jackson Avenue, Evans Place, the Turnpike from Hopper Avenue to Sunset Road and Sunset Road from Turnpike to Boulevard, including sanitary sewer and two pump stations, engineering, surveys and borings, acquisition of properties, construction of a sanitary sewer line, construction management, oversight and traffic control, and legal, advertising and bonding costs, and further including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. The affected properties, listed by block, lot, street address and name of record owner, are referenced on a list on file in the office of the Clerk incorporated by reference as if set forth at length herein and as also set forth in the attached Schedule A."

Section Two. The Township hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section Three. This bond ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by the Local Bond Law.
