## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND APPROPRIATING \$495,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The sum of \$495,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements and purchases:

An amount not exceeding \$5,500.00 for items of expense permitted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.

**SECTION 3.** The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.

**SECTION 4**. This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
