**ORDINANCE NO. 2014-17**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SEWER UTILITY EQUIPMENT PURCHASES AND APPROPRIATING \$170,000.00 FROM THE SEWER UTILITY CAPITAL FUND BALANCE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The sum of \$170,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Utility Capital Fund Balance for the following improvements and equipment purchases:

<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>\$170,000.00</b>


**SECTION 2.** The improvement hereby authorized and the purpose for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$2,000.00 for items of expense permitted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.

**SECTION 3.** The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
