

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-03

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 219 ENTITLED, "FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS AND FOOD AND BEVERAGE MACHINES, RETAIL" OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

WHEREAS, there presently exists a need to regulate retail food establishments within the Township of Pequannock; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Pequannock finds a need to amend the existing retail food establishment regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 88 entitled, "Food and Beverage" shall be amended by the inclusion of a new Section 088.08 entitled "Public Posting of Evaluation Placard" which shall read as follows:

Section 088.08 Public Posting of Evaluation Placard.

Every establishment must post the most current Evaluation Placard according to the following requirements:

The Evaluation Placard must be posted in one of the following prominent locations clearly visible to the patron:

1. The main entrance door from four to six feet off the ground or floor;
2. A front window within five (5) feet of the main entrance;
3. A display case mounted on the outside wall within five (5) feet of the main entrance.
4. If there is no direct entrance to the street, the Health Department shall determine an appropriate posting location in prominent public viewing.


SECTION 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
