

**TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2015-05**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND APPROPRIATING \$537,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL PROJECTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The sum of \$537,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

<b>PURPOSE</b>	<b>Appropriation</b>
(a) Upgrades and repairs to municipal buildings including repairs and Carpet Replacement at Town Hall; Air Filter Replacements at DPW, EMS and Firehouse facilities and Building Improvements at Fire Co #2.	\$59,500
(b) Acquisition of replacement Radio System and Equipment for all Emergency Service agencies	\$160,000
(c) Acquisition of power stretchers for the Pequannock Township First Aid Squad.	\$38,500
(d) Roadway, Sidewalk and Crosswalk improvements on Sunset Road at various locations including, but not limited to, the section from West Parkway to the Boulevard to improve drainage, sidewalks and pedestrian safety improvements.	\$151,000
(e) Construction of Sidewalks along the Boulevard and Sunset Road to replace deteriorated and heaved sections of Sidewalk; Construction of ADA Compliant Intersection Ramps, Replacement of unsafe sidewalk sections and Drainage Improvements throughout the Township.	\$50,000
(f) Drainage system repairs along the rear of Michael Court and drainage improvements at various locations throughout the Township including materials necessary for same	\$78,000
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>\$537,000</b>


**SECTION 2.** The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which these appropriations are made include all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$7,500.00 for items of expense listed in and permitted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.


**SECTION 3.** The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.
