

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-06

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$801,000 FOR FINANCING THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$41,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Fund Balance; \$257,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Vehicle Replacement; \$90,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for DPW Equipment; \$309,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Road Resurfacing; \$33,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Data & Office Equipment; \$71,000 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Flood Control, thereby in aggregate appropriating \$801,000 for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey

PURPOSE	Appropriation
(a) Replace Approximately 15 PC Systems that are 4 years old or older for various municipal offices; purchase of a replacement High Volume Digital Network Copier; and replacement of PC's for the Library and replacement of two ac compressor's for the library.	\$42,500
(b) Traffic Control Equipment including purchase of additional mountable radar display signs and replacement of traffic signal VDS controls.	\$17,000
(c) Purchase trees to replace ones that have died in the public right-of-way.	\$7,500
(d) Resurfacing of various roads in the Township to include milling and paving and various curb and drainage repairs as necessary	\$310,000
(e) Purchase and installation of park equipment including a commercial grade tractor and replacement signage and picnic tables for municipal parks.	\$96,000
(f) Purchase of replacement vehicles including 1) replacement of a command / response vehicle for the Fire Department; 2) replacement of DPW Dump Truck 612; and 3) All weather utility vehicle for the Police Department.	\$257,000
(g) Development of a Flood Control and Home Elevation Master Plan including preparation of a Grant application for home elevation funding.	\$71,000
TOTAL	\$801,000

SECTION 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental


thereto. An amount not exceeding \$77,000 for items of expense listed in and permitted under NJSA 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.

SECTION 3. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
