

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-08

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$575,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

SECTION 1. \$575,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

PURPOSE	Amount Appropriated
(a) Upgrades and repairs to municipal buildings including step repairs, HVAC upgrades and roof replacement at Town Hall, the Library, DPW Annex and Building Improvements at Fire Co #2.	\$ 113,500
(b) Acquisition of replacement Radio System and Equipment for Public Works and all Emergency Service agencies; Police Department Technology upgrades including In-Car & Interview room video equipment.	\$ 214,750
(c) Acquisition of an Ambulance for the Pequannock Township First Aid Squad.	\$ 170,500
(d) Purchase and installation of park equipment including a commercial grade field sprayer and rake and a sod cutter.	\$ 50,250
(e) Design and Engineering associated with the siting and development of a skate park.	\$ 26,000
TOTAL	\$ 575,000

SECTION 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$30,000.00 for items of expense listed in and permitted under NJSA 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.

SECTION 3. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by law.
