

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-14

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$171,000 FROM THE WATER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE WATER UTILITY IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

SECTION 1. \$171,000 is hereby appropriated from the Water Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

PURPOSE	Amount Appropriated
(a) Acquisition and installation of a SCADA System and technology upgrades to link various facilities in the water system.	\$ 115,000
(e) Purchase, Installation and Repair of Equipment and Facilities including digital ph sensing equipment; security fencing at Well #2 and exercising and maintenance of valves within the water system.	\$ 56,000
TOTAL	\$ 171,000


SECTION 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$30,000.00 for items of expense listed in and permitted under NJSA 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.

SECTION 3. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by law.
