ORDINANCE NO. 2017-02

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE DEDICATION OF A RIGHT-OF-WAY KNOWN AS DUNN PLACE.

WHEREAS, Dunn Place was an unimproved road serving two properties and accessing Township owned property; and

WHEREAS, Dunn Place has recently been improved and certified by the Township Engineer to meet minimum required standards for acceptance by the Township as an improved public road; and

WHEREAS, the Township is authorized to accept a dedication of property for use as a public right-of-way, by Ordinance, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-1; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council finds that it would be in the best interest of the Township to accept the dedication of Dunn Place as a public street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

Section 1. Dunn Place is hereby accepted as a public road in the Township of Pequannock.

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
