

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-01

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 185 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK (Wreckers; Service Rates).

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 185 Section 185.13 Entitled "Service Rates" shall be amended to read in its entirety as follows:

Chapter 185 Section 185.13 Service Rates

A. The following is the fee schedule for basic automobile towing services pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.49.

Monday – Sunday (Includes weekends, nights and holidays)

Accident or non- accident

Passenger vehicle and motorcycle towing	\$110.00 (includes in town mileage)
Trucks 5 tons GVW and over	\$280.00 per hour (includes in town mileage)
Mopeds, ATV's etc.	\$80.00 (flat rate)
Police vehicle tow	\$50.00 (flat rate)

B. The following is the fee schedule for services for all types of vehicles pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-2.49 (24 hour day)

Outside storage fees in secure facility

Passenger vehicle storage	\$45.00 per day (24 hour)
Storage for all vehicles over 5 tons GVW	\$55.00 (24 hour)

Recovery and cleanup fees

Basic winching	\$150.00 per hour
Overtured; upright or off-road winching	\$250.00 per hour
Axle pull/drive shaft	\$50.00 flat rate
Hook-up air	\$25.00 flat rate
Basic roadside clean up	\$50.00 per hour
Absorbent	\$25.00 per bag
Additional personnel after driver	\$75.00 per hour
Administration fee for vehicles involved in MVA	\$45.00


SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of Pequannock inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this ordinance.


SECTION 4. This law shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval and publication as required by law.
