



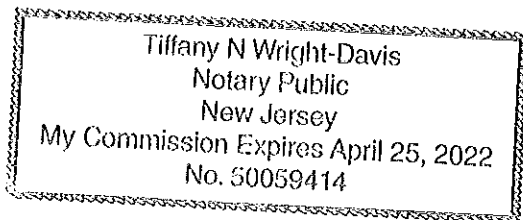

**TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK
BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENT
AND SUMMARY**

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey on May 8, 2018 and the 20 day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such bond ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full bond ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: "Ordinance No. 2018-08, BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ELEVATION OF FLOOD PRONE HOMES IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$5,001,492 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$5,001,492 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP TO FINANCE PART OF THE COST THEREOF"

Purposes: The elevation of flood prone homes, as more specifically described in the Flood Mitigation Assistance Program State-Local Subaward Agreement between the State of New Jersey, Office Of Emergency Management, and the Township on file in the Office of the Clerk, which agreement is hereby incorporated by reference as if set forth at length, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto and further including all related costs and expenditures necessary therefor and incidental thereto.

Appropriation: \$5,001,492

Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$5,001,492
Grants Appropriated: A \$4,322,362 grant being funded by Flood Mitigation Assistance Funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and administered by and through the State of New Jersey Flood Mitigation Assistance Program.

Section 20 Costs: \$750,000

Useful Life: 10 years
