ORDINANCE NO. 2018-20

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,000 FROM THE SEWER UTILITY CAPITAL FUND BALANCE FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE SEWER UTILITY IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

SECTION 1: \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Capital Fund Balance for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey

SECTION 2: The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$2,000 for the items of expense listed in and permitted under NJSA 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvements.

SECTION 3: The Capital Budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.


SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final adoption, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181.
