

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-01

ORDINANCE CHAPTER 177 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK AND AMENDING CERTAIN PARKING REGULATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 177 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Pequannock, Vehicles and Traffic, Subsection 177.15, entitled "Stopping or standing prohibited during certain hours on certain streets" shall be amended to incorporate the following changes to restrictions on the Newark Pompton Turnpike:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Hours & Days</u>	<u>Location</u>
<u>Deleted:</u>			
Newark-Pompton Turnpike	North	All hours	Between existing railroad tracks extending to the north property line of Lot 10 Block 331.
<u>Added:</u>			
Newark-Pompton Turnpike	North	All hours	Between existing NYSW railroad tracks (Morris County Trail Property) extending to Hilton St.
Newark-Pompton Turnpike	North	All hours	Between Richards St. extending north to the north property line of Block 3611, Lot 7 (formally Block 331, Lot 10)

Section 2. Chapter 177 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Pequannock, Vehicles and Traffic, Subsection 177.16, entitled "Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets" shall be amended to incorporate the following changes to restrictions on the Newark-Pompton Turnpike:

Newark Pompton Turnpike	East	Jackson Ave. to Grove St.
Newark Pompton Turnpike	East	Sunset Rd. to Grove St.
<u>Added:</u>		
Newark Pompton Turnpike	East	Jackson Ave. to Sunset Rd.
Newark Pompton Turnpike	East	Hilton St. to the border of Wayne Township
Newark Pompton Turnpike	West	Greenwood Ave. to the border of Wayne Township


Section 3. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
