

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE #2012-12

ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$589,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. \$589,000 is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:


PURPOSE	Amount Appropriated
(a) Upgrades and repairs to municipal buildings including repairs at Town Flail; Sprinkler Pipe Replacement at the Library, Improvements at the Animal Shelter and Replacement of the Apparatus Bay floor at Engine Co #1.	\$ 94,000
(b) Construction of Sidewalks along the Boulevard to replace deteriorated and heaved sections of Sidewalk; Construction of ADA Compliant Intersection Ramps, Replacement of unsafe sidewalk sections and Drainage Improvements throughout the Township,	\$ 61,000
(c) Upgrade & Replacement of street signs to meet visibility standards	\$ 20,250
(d) Roadway and Crosswalk improvements at various locations along the Newark Pompton Turnpike to improve pedestrian safety to include sidewalk and crossing upgrades, improved roadway markings and signage.	\$ 30,250
(e) Improvements to Parks including development of a new field at Washington Park including Field and Parking Facilities and playground equipment at Foothills Park.	\$ 272,750
(f) Purchase and installation of safety and technology equipment for the Police Department including Replacement Defibrillators, LTI Laser Units and a security DVR system for the dispatch area.	\$ 30,250
(g) Purchase of safety and electronic equipment for the Fire Department, including Firefighter Bailout Systems, High Band Pagers and SCBA Mask Replacements.	\$ 19,750
(h) Drainage improvements at various locations throughout the Township including materials necessary for same. Desnagging and clearing of various streams brooks and stormwater drainage components to maintain proper flow for the purpose of flood mitigation.	\$ 60,750
TOTAL	\$589,000

SECTION 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$7,500.00 for items of expense listed in and permitted under NJSA 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.

SECTION 3. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by law.
