

**TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK**

**ORDINANCE #2012-13**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$330,000 FOR FINANCING THEREOF.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1, \$39,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Fund Balance; \$8,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Vehicle Replacement; \$36,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for DPW Equipment; \$204,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Road Resurfacing; \$43,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Data & Office Equipment, thereby in aggregate appropriating \$330,000 for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

<b>PURPOSE</b>	<b>Amount Appropriated</b>
(a) Replace Approximately 15 PC Systems that are 4 years old or older for various municipal offices; purchase of a replacement Network Copier; replacement of a Network Server; and replacement of PC's for the Library and replacement of two ac compressor's for the library.	\$52,000
(b) Resurfacing of various roads in the Township to include milling and paving and various curb and drainage repairs as necessary.	\$204,000
(c) Purchase and installation of Park equipment including basketball backboards and rims; signage for Parks, and Kayaks & Paddle Boats for Woodland Lake.	\$19,750
(d) Purchase of Equipment for use by the Public Works Department including an Air Compressor; A/C Recovery / Charge machine, Ballfield Groome and a Field Line Striper.	\$36,000
(e) Purchase of a 2-1/2 Ton High Wheeled Vehicle for use by the Fire Department	\$8,000
(f) Purchase trees to replace ones that have died in the public right-of-way.	\$ 10,250
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>\$ 330,000</b>


SECTION 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the purposes for which this appropriation is made includes all costs and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto. An amount not exceeding \$7,500 for items of expense listed in and permitted under NJSA 40A:2-20 is included in the costs indicated herein for the improvement.


SECTION 3. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by law.
