- Time & Place** The minutes of the Workshop Meeting of the Pequannock Township Council, County of Morris, New Jersey, held
- Present** The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P.M. with the Engelbart, Kapotes, Skvarca, Vanderhoff; Attorney Oostdyk; Manager Hollberg and Township Clerk Sweeney.
- Mayor Jorgensen announced that requirements of Public Law c.231 have been complied with for this meeting through notice of date, time, place and proposed Agenda newspaper.
- Public Discussion** Ann Johnson - 16 Romondt Road - Pompton Plains Spoke about her neighbor who brought in a truck full of dirt and put the dirt (about 12 inches) along side of her property. He then put up a fence on top of the dirt. Being in a flood zone, she is concerned that this will cause bigger flooding on her property. She spoke with Mr. Herrmann and Bob Grant about the situation. They came to her house and looked at everything and agreed with her.
- Manager Hollberg said the Township is aware of this. Mr. Hermann and Mr. Grant have taken certain actions to get him to comply, but he is not willing. The enforcement process is a lengthy one if we have to go through additional steps. Your neighbor made an offer to make minor remedial steps and the Township responded that it was inadequate.
- Mayor Jorgensen said this problem will be pursued, but it might be a lengthy process.
