Time & Place	The minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Pequannock Township Council, County of Morris, New Jersey, held October 23, 2007 in the Municipal Building.

Public Discussion	Edward Mann - 12 Copley Court - Pompton Plains Presented the Township Council with a petition from the residents of Copley Court. They are opposed of using an open field at the end of their street becoming a Parks and Recreation field. They feel that this will bring a large volume of cars down their street. Mayor Vanderhoff explained that the town needs more fields and this would be used for soccer practice.
