WHEREAS, In 2007, over 180,000 new cases of female invasive breast cancer will be diagnosed with over 41,000 women ultimately dying from the disease; and

WHEREAS, Early detection and improved treatment are believed to have a direct correlation to the declining death rates from breast cancer; and

WHEREAS, The most effective method of detecting breast changes long before physical symptoms can be seen or felt is mammography, an "x-ray" of the breast; and

WHEREAS, The New Jersey State Federation of Women's Clubs of GFWC and the Woman's Club of Pompton Plains, as a member of the Federation, joins with women's clubs throughout the State of New Jersey in urging women to receive annual mammograms.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED THAT I, JOEL D. VANDERHOFF, Mayor of Pequannock Township, do hereby proclaim the month of October to be National Breast Cancer Awareness Month, and October 19 to be National Mammography Day in our community.
