There were no members of the public in attendance.


Township Manager Adam Brewer provided information on the draft 2022 Municipal Budget and recommended the Council consider the direction of the township for the next 5 to 10 years.

Members of the Council, Mr. Brewer and Ms. Kupilik reviewed the draft budget including the current fund, revenues, utilities and capital.


Members of the Council requested additional information on capital projects, discussed road conditions, Fire Department expenses and First Aid contributions.
