Township Manager Adam Brewer reviewed amendments to the draft 2021 Municipal Budget reflecting direction given at the prior budget workshop meeting.


Members of the Council, Mr. Brewer and Ms. Kupilik discussed various topics related to the budget. It was determined no additional budget workshops would be necessary.
