- Gail met with Carey Adler, owner of Spa 23 with regards to setting up exercise programs for the seniors. He has researched the Silver Sneakers program, but his health club chose not to participate. Carey will work on putting something together and another meeting will take place in mid-January.
- Gail met with all Chief of Police regarding collaborating with New Bridge Services to offer a 'Mental Health First Aid for First Responders' program. All municipalities are interested. This event will likely take place late February or March of 2017.

Bloomingdale: Silver Sneakers was contacted via email to see if the Bloomingdale Senior Center could be used as a site to host this program. Gail is still waiting for a reply.

Bloomingdale: "Stigma Free" communities researched. Passaic County Mental Health Association was contacted via email for collaboration with startup ideas as well as information on forming a task force.

Monday Campaigns: This campaign is being considered for early 2017. Messages via social media (possibly marquis) disseminated on Mondays. The campaign aims to change behaviors. Research shows that Mondays are the best day of the week for people to make diet, exercise, quit smoking and schedule doctor appointments. Periodic, frequent messages have the power to improve health behaviors.

Gail reached out to NORWESCAP regarding having some of the staff certified to teach programs for seniors 55+. "Healthy Bones" and "A Matter of Balance" are most popular and in need of instructors.
