- Partridge Trail: Hoarding complaint

### **Pequannock:**

- Meyer Place: Vegetation

- Evans Pl.: Garbage and debris dumped in dumpster area
- Turnpike: Broken window on entrance door
- Boulevard: Rodents, property maintenance, poison ivy
- Little Food Café: Fire

- Evans Road: Homeowner feeding wildlife
- Brown Ct.: Mold in rental home (unconfirmed)

## **TASE Inspections:**
