ORDINANCE NO. 2020-13

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF WEST SUNSET AVENUE AS A
PUBLIC ROAD**

WHEREAS, West Sunset Road is an improved road serving as access to several properties which has been serviced and maintained by the Township for many years; and

WHEREAS, West Sunset Road has been improved sufficiently for the Township Engineer to recommend acceptance by the Township as an improved public road; and

WHEREAS, the Township is authorized to accept a property for use as a public right-of-way, by Ordinance, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:67-1; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council finds that it would be in the best interest of the Township to accept West Sunset Road as a public road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

Section 1. West Sunset Road as shown on the Tax Map of the Township of Pequannock is hereby accepted as a public road in the Township of Pequannock.

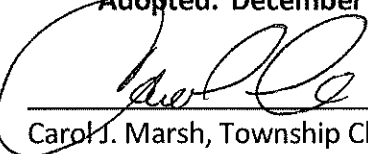
Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

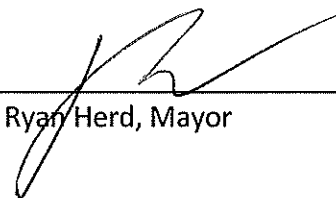
Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
