

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-10

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$398,200 FOR FINANCING THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

SECTION 1. \$313,200 from the Capital Improvement Fund; and \$45,000 is hereby appropriated from the Reserve for Vehicle Replacements; and \$40,000 is hereby appropriated from the Reserve for DPW Equipment thereby in aggregate appropriating \$398,200 for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

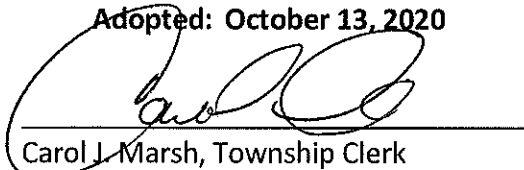
Purpose	Amount Appropriated
(a) Technology Upgrades and Acquisitions Including but not Limited to Server Upgrades & Workstation Replacements	\$26,200
(b) Fire Equipment Upgrades and Acquisitions Including but not limited to Scott Cylinders	\$51,000
(c) Acquisition and Upgrades to Law Enforcement Equipment Including but not Limited to: MDT Replacements, Radar Units, ALPR Units, and Laser Radar Units	\$101,000
(d) Roadway Improvements Including but not limited to Sidewalk Improvements and Traffic Signals	\$135,000
(e) Vehicle Acquisitions Including but not limited to an Excavator with Trailer and a Pickup Truck	\$85,000
TOTAL	\$ 398,200

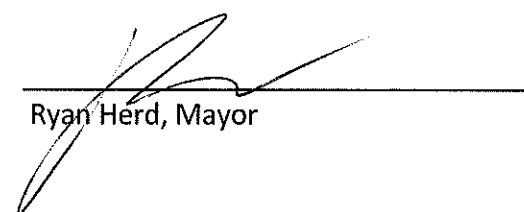
SECTION 2. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final adoption, as provided by law.
