PV Park Badge Information

**Badges must be renewed annually*

Badge Renewal: If you have a badge from 2020, you may renew online using Community Pass.
register.communitypass.net/Pequannock

To access this page, you can find the link on the Parks & Recreation homepage. Once paid, your badge will automatically update for the new season.

First-Time Badge Members: Register online through Community Pass.
register.communitypass.net/Pequannock

If you don't have an account, follow the prompts to create one. After paying for the membership(s), come to the Parks & Recreation office to get your picture taken for your badge. **Those two years old and up must have a badge.**

Lost Badge: \$20 replacement fee

Gate Entry: Each time you enter the facility you will be asked to present the gate guard with your badge for scanning or pay the daily rate.

2021 Rules & Regulations

PV Park Rules & Regulations are designed to help insure the safety and enjoyment of all park attendees. Failure to comply with the policies set may result in suspension or forfeiture of lake privileges. The following policies are based on Township Ordinances; prosecution may result from abuses to these rules.

1. Persons age 14 and up do not require a chaperone.
2. Children under the age of 14 require an adult (18+) chaperone.
3. Children under the age of 14 must pass a swim test to go out to the raft/dock.
4. Inflatable water paraphernalia is restricted to the shallow area (not beyond the ropes). This includes toys, beach balls, inner tubes, snorkels, facemasks, fins, etc.
5. Strictly prohibited:
 - * Disorderly conduct
 - * Horseplay, ball playing (except in designated areas)
 - * Littering
 - * Alcoholic beverages (coolers will be checked at gate)
 - * Smoking (including electronic cigarettes)
6. Music and television volumes must be kept at a level low enough not to disturb other patrons.
7. Diaper changing tables are located in both men's and ladies' restrooms. Swim diapers **MUST** be worn.
8. Diving Restrictions include, but are not limited to:
 - * One diver on the board at a time
 - * No excessive bouncing
 - * You must be certain the person ahead of you has surfaced and cleared the water before jumping
 - * Patrons using the 3-meter board (high dive) must meet the height requirement; lifeguard approval of height is necessary before accessing the board.
9. All park users must obey park staff.
10. Membership badges are **NOT** transferable.
11. Badges must be scanned when entering the park.
12. Swimming is restricted to supervised areas only.
13. Swimming and wading may be restricted to certain areas due to special activities or low attendance.

Diving Board Test

Persons taking the diving board test will first jump or dive off the diving board into the deep water. They must then tread water for ten seconds. From there they must swim, unaided, on their stomachs (freestyle, breaststroke, or doggy paddle) to the blue pole to the left of the diving board. Then they may push off the bottom and return to the ladder next to the diving board, swimming in the same fashion as they did going to the blue pole. All persons will have a lifeguard accompanying them for safety. It is not possible to pass this test if said person receives assistance from the lifeguard at any time during the test. Persons may only take the diving board test once per day.

Deep Water Test

Persons under the age of 14 must take the test to go out to the dock. Participants must jump off the low dive, resurface, and then float on their backs for 30 seconds. During floating, the swimmer must have body parallel to the surface of the water and head facing upwards. Participant will have the option of using either the breaststroke or front-crawl (freestyle). Once stroke is selected, swimmer will swim to the dock. At the dock, the swimmer will tread water for 30 seconds and swim back to the shallow end towards B+G lifeguard stand. During treading, swimmer must keep head above water and use slow movements (egg beater legs or breaststroke kick movement) to stay stationary. Swimmers testing must have strong stroke and swimming skills. It is the staff's discretion to confirm that participant has passed, even if the swimmer had completed each task. The swimmer fails the test if the swimmer stops or swimmer's stroke is not consistent. If staff advises participant to stop and get on the surfboard, participant must obey. It is recommended that the participant take the advice of staff for improvements and when it would be best to retake the test. If the swimmer passes, paperwork is completed and a wristband is given to show the test was successful.

Group and Party Fees

All groups of more than twenty-five (25) must have prior approval from Parks & Recreation and must provide a certificate of insurance naming Pequannock Township as additionally insured.

Camps or Daycare Groups Providing Supervision

Group User Rate (annual):

\$575 facility use fee plus

\$6.00/child for FULL Day

\$4.00/child for HALF Day (up to four hours)

Non-Profit Group Rate (annual):

\$288.00 facility use fee plus

\$3.00/child for FULL Day

\$2.00/child for HALF Day (up to four hours)

All groups will submit a daily count to the Park Manager; this is subject to verification by park staff.

Party Packages

Up to 25 People:

\$173 facility use fee plus \$6 per person at gate

26-50 People:

\$230 facility fee plus \$6 per person at gate

51+ People:

\$345 facility fee plus \$6 per person at gate

All packages include use of picnic tables and grills.
