**ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE
TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK WATER UTILITY, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS,
STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$45,000 FOR
FINANCING THEREOF**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

SECTION 1. \$45,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund for the following improvements in and by the Water Utility of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

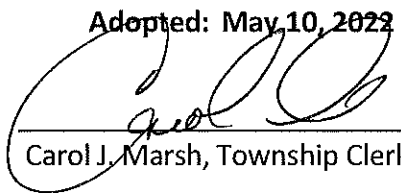
Purpose	Amount Appropriated
a. Water System Improvements, Maintenance, & Upgrades Including, but not Limited to, Hydrants/Meters, Valve Exercising Program, & Corrosion Control	\$ 20,000
b. Water Meter Services and Installation Parts	\$ 25,000
TOTAL	\$ 45,000

SECTION 2. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.

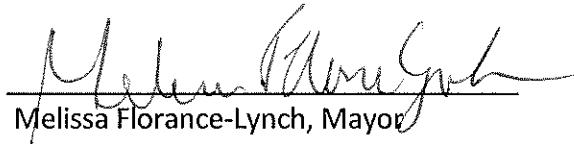
SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final adoption, as provided by law.
