

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-07

**ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE
TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW
JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$995,602 FOR FINANCING THEREOF**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

SECTION 1. \$948,602 from the Capital Improvement Fund; \$40,000 is hereby appropriated from Reserve for Flood Improvements; and \$7,000 is hereby appropriated from the Reserve for DPW Equipment thereby in aggregate appropriating **\$995,602** for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

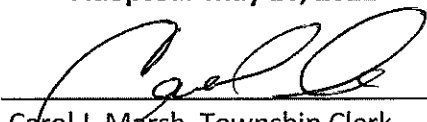

(a) Technology Upgrades and Acquisitions Including but not Limited to: Server Upgrades, Printer/ Copiers, Workstation Replacements, and Wireless Access Point Upgrades	\$ 29,500
(b) Fire Department Equipment Including but not Limited to Scott Cylinder Replacements, Hose, and Vehicle Replacements	\$ 108,500
(c) Traffic and Roadway Improvements Including but not Limited to: Road Resurfacing, Drainage Improvements, Sidewalk Improvements, and Crack Sealing	\$ 330,000
(d) Vehicle Replacements Including but not Limited to Dump Trucks, Sweepers, Tractors, and other Municipal Fleet Vehicles	\$ 219,000
(e) Upgrades to Municipal Facilities and Parks Including but not Limited to: Improvements to the Fire Safety Building, Townhall, Shade Trees, and Improvements to Park Facilities	\$ 196,000
(f) First Aid Squad Vehicles Including but not Limited to: Fleet Vehicles and Ambulances	\$ 60,000
(g) Police, Dispatch, & Law Enforcement Equipment Including but not Limited to: Lawsoft Records Management Software, Patrol Rifle Program, Holsters, and related Office Equipment	\$ 52,602
TOTAL	\$ 995,602

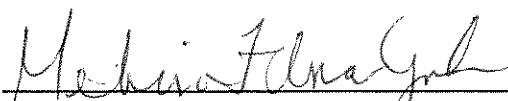
SECTION 2. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.
