



Reception/Admin

There is no specific Global Design direction for Receptions, but the examples shown are effective and provide a professional first impression for visitors.

The inclusion of timber in the design helps make the space feel welcoming.





Staffrooms & Utility Spaces

The preference for Staffrooms is to provide an agile working environment similar to the Open Learning Centres. Staff are allocated a locker for their personal belongings and different work settings are provided.

The spaces provided allow for quiet/focused work, informal meetings, eating & drinking, collaborative working etc.


The use of timber and provision of plants in the space helps to make the staffroom an inviting place to work or have a break.

Kaipara Staffroom is an innovative learning environment and creates a level of coherence across the school for our values and learning model. The positives are that there are break out rooms for holding meetings and having private conversations when required, but it is a level playing field for all staff — no offices for leaders everyone in the same space. This supports the notion of everyone working as a team. We promote people working flexibly in different spaces, having flexible working groups. Using different spaces as a work station emulates what we are expecting for students.

As a leader getting rid of an office promotes accessibility to staff, a more collegial environment, and a lowering of hierarchical leadership models and increasing a sense of team and collaboration. Our collaboration spaces work to facilitate this attitude and behaviour amongst staff.





Generally white ceiling with white walls and grey carpet.

Colored band above door height to some walls helps to brighten up the space. Colorful, flexible furniture options. Tables with a mix of white, writable surfaces and timber laminate. Multiple different types of seating including colorful bean bags, various height chairs, ottomans and stadium type soft seating. Focused working booths and collaboration settings with VC Screens/whiteboards. Glass fronted Studio Classrooms off open learning space for line-of-sight.







Typical Technical Studio

Makerspace, Science Room or Art Studio, these spaces all have a grey vinyl floor, white walls and hard-wearing surfaces on standing height, mobile tables. Cabinets around the perimeter of the room and adjacent storage rooms.






Typical Gymnasium Simple portal framed construction with natural, earthy color exterior.









White Entry Signage to Main Entry. Internal Signage on grey background













Large multi-colored room number with STUDIO written up the door




Senior School Collaborative
