

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 152 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK AND REVISING FEES FOR CERTAIN PARKS AND RECREATION ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 152, "Fees", of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Pequannock, Section 152-32 entitled "Chapter 237, Parks and Recreation", shall be amended by the following changes to Subsection B(3) which shall read, in its entirety, as follows:

B. Fees for badges and use of Pequannock Valley (PV) Park and Woodland Lake.

(3) Groups. All groups of more than 25 must have prior approval of the Director of Parks and Recreation or the park manager and the following fees shall apply:

(a) Camps or day-care groups providing supervision and insurance:

- [1] Group user rate (annual): **\$625 facility use fee** plus **\$7 per child per full day, \$5 per child per half day** (four hours maximum).
- [2] Nonprofit groups (annual): **\$300 facility use fee** plus \$3 per child per full day, \$2 per child per half day (four hours maximum).

(b) Party package (daily). Includes use of picnic table and grills.

- [1] Up to 25 people: \$173 facility use fee plus \$6 per person.
- [2] 26 to 50 people: \$230 facility use fee plus \$6 per person.
- [3] 51+ people: \$345 facility use fee plus \$6 per person.

(c) All group users will submit a daily log to the park manager. Logs are subject to verification by park staff. The amount due will be determined at the end of each week and must be paid in full prior to entering the park the following week.

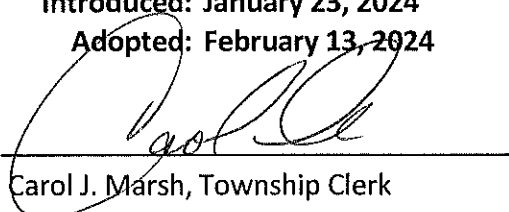
Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

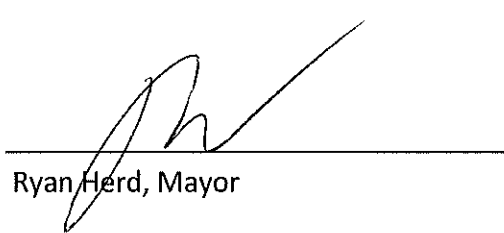
Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
