ORDINANCE CANCELLING CERTAIN CAPITAL PROJECT BALANCES TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND AND REAPPROPRIATING \$103,000 AS AN IMPROVEMENT AUTHORIZATION FOR TOWN HALL BUILDING IMPROVEMENTS AND FURTHER APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$248,000 AS AN IMPROVEMENT AUTHORIZATION, FOR DESIGN AND PLANNING OF RENOVATIONS AND UPGRADES TO TOWN HALL AND OTHER PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, certain unused capital project balances, in the sum of \$351,000, are reflected on the records of the Township of Pequannock, which the Township Council finds it appropriate and necessary to re-appropriate these balances as indicated below:

- 3. The Capital budget is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.
- 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent necessary.
- 5. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final adoption, in accordance with N.J.S.A 40:69A-18.
