ORDINANCE NO. 2019-02

ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 182 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, SECTION 182.02, ENTITLED WATER CHARGES

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock wishes to amend the above captioned ordinance to identify the calculation of water usage charge:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I. Chapter 182 entitled WATER of the Code of the Township of Pequannock, Section 182.02, entitled "WATER CHARGES," specifically subsection 182.02.020, entitled "RATES GENERALLY", is amended to read as follows:

SUBSECTION 182.02.020 Rates Generally

The following rates are hereby established for consumption of water from township water mains:

A. Consumption Rates per Thousand Gallons

B. Account Service Charges

In addition to Consumption Billing as described in Subsection A the following quarterly charge shall be applied to each water meter, except those covered by Subsection C of this subsection:

C. Charges for Multi-Unit Dwelling Buildings Supplied Through a Single Meter

1. All multi-unit dwellings supplied through a single meter are subject to the following account service charge for each meter in service

2. The threshold for charging the higher tiered consumption rate listed in Subsection A (greater than 30,000 gallons) for multi-unit dwelling supplied through a single meter shall be calculated by multiplying the number of individual units served through the meter by 30,000 gallons. The higher rate shall be charged for the consumption in excess of this amount

D. No Amendment

E. Bulk Water/ Whole Sale Water Rate to Other Municipalities

The following rate schedule is established for the bulk sale of water to other municipally owned water utilities and bulk commercial users who consumer in excess of 3,000,000 gallons per month. Bulk water delivered under this paragraph shall be billed monthly. The rate is per 1,000 gallons

SECTION II. The remaining sections of Chapter 182 shall remain unchanged.

SECTION III. If any section, paragraph, sentence, (or part thereof) shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of law, such decision shall not affect the remaining sections, paragraphs or sentences (or parts thereof) of the Ordinance.


SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect after passage and publication as provided by law.
