ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 43 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK AND INCREASING THE NUMBER OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CLUB LICENSES TO FOUR

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 43 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Pequannock, "Alcoholic Beverages", Subsection 43.01.04, entitled "Number of License Issued Limited" shall be amended to increase the number of club licenses from three (3) to four (4).

Section 2. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the manner provided by law.
