

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-07

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$1,203,000 FOR FINANCING THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

SECTION 1. \$64,000 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for DPW Equipment; \$304,800 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Road Resurfacing; \$15,500 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Data & Office Equipment, \$818,700 from the Capital Improvement Fund thereby in aggregate appropriating \$1,203,000 for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

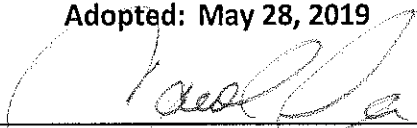

(a) Technology Upgrades and Acquisitions Including but not Limited to Server Upgrades, Phone Handset Replacements, and Annual PC Upgrades	\$ 44,700
(b) Fire Equipment Upgrades and Acquisitions Including but not limited to Scott Cylinders and SCBA Replacements	\$ 54,500
(c) Roadway, Sidewalk, and Drainage Improvements at Various Locations Around the Township Including but not Limited to Roadway Resurfacing on Lockwood and Dale, Winfield, Van Riper and Davis, DeBow and Berry, and Hillview and Beaverbrook; Drainage on Greenview	\$ 511,300
(d) Acquisition of DPW Equipment Including but not Limited to Acquisition of a Salt Brine Applicator, Traffic Signals, Tree Truck, and Tractors	\$ 330,500
(e) Building Improvements, Acquisitions, and Upgrades to Municipal Facilities Including but not Limited to Senior House Window Replacement, Roof Replacement at DPW, Resealing of Fire Company #2 Bay Floors, Fire Department Digital Message Boards, Municipal Building Structural Improvements	\$ 217,000
(f) Purchase of Trees to Replace Ones in the Public Right of Way	\$ 7,000
(g) Improvements to Parks and Recreation Facilities Including but not Limited to the Resurfacing of the PV Park Basketball Court	\$ 10,000
(h) Acquisition and Upgrades to Law Enforcement Equipment Including but not Limited to Upgrade to Lawsoft Records Management, Acquisition of a Gun Safe, and Increased Video Storage	\$28,000
TOTAL	\$ 1,203,000

SECTION 2. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.

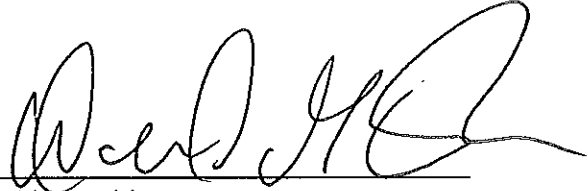
SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after the first publication thereof after final adoption, as provided by law.
