

TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-06

ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VARIOUS CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF PEQUANNOCK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$559,800 FOR FINANCING THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Pequannock, County of Morris, as follows:

SECTION 1. \$250,000 is hereby appropriated from the General Capital Reserve for Road Resurfacing; \$254,500 from the Capital Improvement Fund; and \$55,300 is hereby appropriated from General Capital Fund Balance thereby in aggregate appropriating \$559,800 for the following improvements in and by the Township of Pequannock, in the County of Morris, New Jersey:

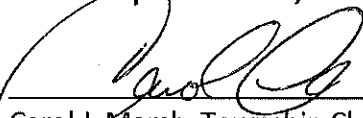

(a) Technology Upgrades and Acquisitions Including but not Limited to server Upgrades	\$20,000
(b) Fire Equipment Upgrades and Acquisitions Including but not limited to AED's & Scott Cylinders	\$55,000
(c) Acquisition and Upgrades to Law Enforcement Equipment Including but not Limited to: Lawsoft Records Management & Technology Upgrades/ Replacements within Police Vehicles	\$26,500
(d) Roadway Improvements at Various Locations Around the Township Including but not Limited to: the Alexander Ave Area, Cameron Ave, Della Ave, Pomona Ave, Mandeville Ave, & the Van Ness Ave Area	\$360,300
(e) Building Improvements, Acquisitions, and Upgrades to Municipal Facilities Including but not Limited to: Heat/ AC Upgrades Fire Safety House & the Roof at the Public Works Annex	\$98,000
TOTAL	\$ 559,800

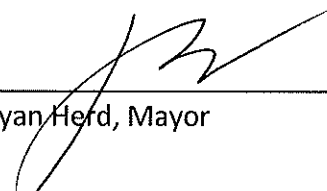
SECTION 2. The Capital Budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies herewith.
