NOTICE TO BIDDERS

14 Cubic Yard Self Contained Trailer Mounted Leaf Loader

The Township of Pequannock, New Jersey shall receive sealed proposals at the Municipal Building, 530 Newark-Pompton Turnpike, Pompton Plains, NJ, 07444, Office of the Township Manager until 11:00 a.m., prevailing time, Thursday, July 30, 2020 for the 14 Cubic Yard Self Contained Trailer Mounted Leaf Loader.

Requirements and contract documents for the proposed work are on file at the Township Manager's Office, 530 Newark-Pompton Turnpike, Pompton Plains, NJ, 07444 on and after Wednesday, July 15, 2020 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding legal holidays and will be made available by contacting the Township Manager via e-mail at manager@peqtwp.org. There is no cost for this bid specification.

Proposals must be accompanied by a Bid Deposit in the form of a Bid Bond, Certified Check, Money Order or Cashier's Check in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total amount bid, provided said check or bond need not be more than \$20,000.00. This contract does not require a Performance Bond.

In accordance with Local Finance Notice 2020-10, bids shall be opened in a modified public format. In-person attendance by bidders and/or the general public shall not be permitted due to the current state of emergency. In lieu of same, all bidders shall be provided instructions for web-conference access prior to the opening. A live-stream link will also be posted on the Township's website prior to the opening for use by the general public.

Each proposal must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, bearing the name and address of the bidder and shall be addressed to the **TOWNSHIP MANAGER'S OFFICE** and on or before the hour mentioned above. Envelope or Package must be clearly endorsed with "SEALED BID" and the contract name.

1. This solicitation will be awarded via a Fair and Open Process in accordance with *N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5 et seq.*
2. Bidder must be registered with the State of New Jersey at time of the award of the contract. Bidders will be required to present a copy of their Business Registration Certificate (BRC).
3. Bidders must provide an Ownership Disclosure Affidavit with bid proposal, failure to provide the same is a non-waivable defect.
4. Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of *N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq.* and *N.J.A.C. 17:27*.
